

A BRIEF HISTORY

Master's Circle Christian Fellowship International, Inc.

Bishop Robert Wilson for many years has had a burden for ministers of small churches and the quality of leadership available to them. He believes God called him to be a Pastor to Pastors. It is out of this deep conviction and his desire to fulfill the call to prepare God's people for the works of service so that the Body of Christ may be built up in unity, faith, and in the knowledge of Christ.

At the center of his vision is the training of ministers to rightly dividing the word of truth by Christian leaders who are committed to affirming the integrity of the Word of God.

In April 2008, at the request of Archbishop Grant B. Williams Jr., a meeting took place with then Bishop Robert E. Wilson, Jr. This meeting led to the formation of the Master's Circle Christian Fellowship International, Inc. (MCCFI). The ministers who came together as founders were the Reverend Van Jones, Reverend Lee McClain, Father Anthony Webster, reverend Larry Powell, and Bishop Robert E. Wilson, Jr. The met collectively to form as an Episcopal ministry organization. It was then established that

their main priority would be leading others to Jesus Christ and making disciples, while developing leaders. Understanding the growing needs of ministries, they agreed to focus on and enhance leadership and administrative skills for small and medium sized churches.

On the 18th of November, 2008, a meeting was held for the purpose of organizing the infrastructure to establish a Christian fellowship with special emphasis in the development and support of the small church and to improve the quality of ministry at all levels. This meeting was called by Bishop Robert E. Wilson, Jr. and attended by Father. Anthony Webster, father Oscar Grant, Pastor Larry Powell, Pastor Van T. Jones, and Deacon Anthony N. Webster.

The first agenda item presented to the body was the need to establish some core offices and assign functional responsibility. The primary objective was to "hit the ground running." The Master's Circle Christian fellowship was born for the above reasons and purposes.



A BRIEF HISTORY (continued)

Master's Circle Christian Fellowship International, Inc.


With much prayer and planning, MCCFI was legally established and incorporated on December 9, 2008. The fellowship was sanctioned at the first Holy Convocation in July 2009, by Archbishop Grant B. Williams Jr., Bishop Theodeus Green, then as Reverend Anthony Williams, Bishop Robert E. Wilson, Jr., and Bishop Elbert Williams. Father Anthony Webster became the first consecration Bishop of Master's Circle Christian Fellowship International, Incorporated.

Through the years, MCCFI, has had a spiritual and biblical impact on its surrounding communities worldwide. Our outreach included donations to clothes closets, food baskets and pantries for holidays, school supplies for children and youth, as well as scholarships and programs. Including the joy of giving holiday gifts to children from single families homes and those with incarcerated parent(s) that needed assistance.

Earlier on, The Master's Circle Christian

Fellowship has had as a key goal to preserve the legacy of Archbishop Grant B. Williams, Jr. An idea was put forth to establish a "Bishop's Chair" in his name that would be honored annually by a worthy recipient; especially for their service to the Lord in the field of Missions. The Perpetual Bishop Williams and Elect Lady Missions Chair" has been approved by the fellowship and this will be an annual recognition at the Annual Holy Convocation. Candidates for the achievement will be submitted via applications from the fellowship Body and from notable people of the communities involved. Later in the group's discussion, it was decided that it would be appropriate to do something similar for another devoted servant of God, Dr. Barry R. Copeland.

MCCFI is designed and will continue to address the whole church, the whole man while reaching out globally to ministry partners.





Archbishop Robert E. Wilson, Jr., Ph.D. BIOGRAPHY

Born March 16, 1949, second of eight children from the marriage of Robert E. Wilson, Sr. and Jerusha Elaine Wilson.

Archbishop Wilson accepted Jesus Christ May 20, 1980 and was called to Ministry in April 1983 at Mount Sinai Baptist Church, under the late Dr. David Durham. He taught Sunday School, Wednesday night Bible classed, and was one of the founding teachers at Faith Bible College and Seminary, along with President Edwin Jones, Ph.D. and Vice-President Grant B. Williams, Jr., Ph.D.

A career executive officer with over 36 years of supervisory, ministerial, and counseling expertise. Archbishop Wilson has earned degrees with Associates in Business Administration, Jefferson Business School, Elizabeth, New Jersey, Bachelor of Science, District of Columbia Bible Institute, Washington D.C., Masters of Pastoral Theology in Biblical Studies, Liberty University, Lynchburg, Virginia. An astute educator and

evaluator of the various human conditions associated with reconciling dysfunctional families.

"As a certified counselor and educator, who can also train and certify others to become counselors, I have made many executive decisions and policies that have changed lives. My vision is to unite families in order to create a strong church, community, and country. I continually demonstrate leadership, and executive management expertise, and have highly qualified to serve as the Chief Executive Officer (Senior Pastor) of Rightly Divide the Word of Truth Church and Ministries Center, Word of Truth Ministries International, President of Truth University, Now, The Presiding Archbishop of the Master's Circle Christian Fellowship International Inc., and Archdiocese of Polycarp of The Province of St. Peter of Communion of Evangelical Episcopal Churches."

We stand within a tradition where God calls and empowers deacons, elders, and ministers of Word and sacrament.

The Presiding Bishop invites the candidates forward, saying:

The Master's Circle Christian Fellowship's Ordination and Licensing Counsel has elected the following people to be ordained to the Office of Elder; *NN/s* (using full names),

- Minister Gayle J. Coles
- Minister Dr. Edward Crisp
- Minister Denette Casey

The candidates shall remain standing; the presiding minister continues:

Elders are called to serve as Christ served. We look to them to be people of spiritual commitment, exemplary life, compassionate spirit, and sound judgment.

Elders are set apart for a ministry of watchful and responsible care for the welfare and order of the church.

They have oversight of all members, including one another, the deacons, and the ministers, equipping everyone to live in harmony with God's Word.

They ensure the Word of God is rightly proclaimed and taught, and the sacraments faithfully administered.

Elders assist the minister/s with their good counsel, and serve all Christians with advice, consolation, and encouragement.

Bishops, Elders, ministers, and deacons, together form the consistory to lead God's people in proclaiming good news to the poor, righteousness to the nations, and peace among all.

The consistory provides for the welfare of the church, stewardship of property and finance, and the spiritual benefit and growth of all Christ's people.

As the three offices of Bishop, elder, and minister of Word and sacrament, are united in Christ, so also in the church one office is not separate from the others.

The Bishop of Word and sacrament does not serve without the elder and neither without the minister/deacon.

Together they enable the whole mission of the church. Everything in the church will be done decently and in order when faithful persons are called to office, and responsibly fulfil their charge.

The Presiding Bishop addresses the elders-elect:

Brothers and sisters, before almighty God, and in the presence of this congregation, answer sincerely these questions:

Do you confess together with us and the church throughout the ages your faith in one God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit?

Elders -elects: Yes, truly, with all my heart.

The Presiding Bishop shall invite the congregation to stand:

Let us all stand with these brothers and sisters, confessing our faith in the words of the Apostles' Creed.

I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.
I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried;

On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, he is seated at the right hand of the Father, and he will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy universal Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

The congregation is seated; the candidates remain standing; the Presiding Bishop addresses the candidates:

Do you believe in your heart that you are called by Christ's church, and therefore by God, to this office?

Yes, truly, with all my heart.

Do you believe the books of the Old and New Testaments to be the Word of God and the perfect doctrine of salvation, rejecting all contrary beliefs?

Yes, truly, with all my heart.

Will you be diligent in your study of Holy Scripture and in your use of the means of grace?

Will you pray for God's people and lead them by your own example in faithful service and holy living?

I will, and I ask God to help me.

Will you accept the church's order and governance, submitting to ecclesiastical discipline should you become delinquent in either life or doctrine?

I will, and I ask God to help me.

Will you be loyal to the witness and work of the **Master's Circle Christian Fellowship International, Incorporated,** using all your abilities to further its Christian mission here and throughout the world?

I will, and I ask God to help me.

ORDINATION

Those who are to be ordained shall kneel individually before the Presiding Bishop for prayer with the laying on of hands. The great consistory may join in the laying on of hands during the prayer. When all have come forward and are in place, the Presiding Bishop shall say:




Dr. Dula served in Vietnam and was responsible for the transport and care of the dying and the dead from the combat zones in South East Asia.




